## What is Expo 2025 Osaka?

> **When:** 13 April 2025 – 13 October 2025 (183 days)

> Venue: Yumeshima, Osaka

> **Participating Countries:** 160 countries/regions and 9 international organizations have signed up.

> Projected Visitors

Total: Approx. 28.2 million

Daily: Approx. 154.000

Expected that visitors will mainly be Japanese or

from the East-Asian region (90%!)




The VIP Event Room at the Netherlands pavilion is a multifunctional space designed to organise various events and cater to the different needs of a variety of guests

Space up to 50 guests


For sit-down lunches and dinners this is a spacious set-up with eight tables, with room for six guests per table.

Space for 80 seated guests


Auditorium-style set-up. Your guests are seated in comfortable chairs in front of, and towards the side of the stage. There is space for up to 80 guests in chairs and an additional 20 guests that can sit on the benches at the side and back-end of the room.





# Venue options: networking event





Space for about 100 guests

About eight to ten standing tables are placed throughout the room, at which your guests can enjoy a drinks and some snacks as they interact with each other in a casual setting. The capacity of a network event using the whole pavilion (including shop, bar, hall) can be expanded to 200 guests.




